

## **Burnaby Judo Club** **Member Assistance Criteria**

### **General**

Member assistance will only be awarded to club members to participate in competitive and judo development activities provided that a surplus of funds exists above and beyond the club's regular operating expenses in a given period of operation.

#### **Regular Club Operating Expenses include:**

- Instructional Fees
- Coaching Expenses
- Administrative Expenses
- Rental Fees
- Replacement of new, lost or worn equipment
- Annual Recognition for Club Volunteers
- Costs associated with the club's annual awards dinner/picnic

### **Funding Levels**

The total funding available will be shared proportionately among all club members based on a demonstrated need or an excess availability of club funds.

Proportions allocated to each group (i.e., competitive, junior and recreational) as well as funding levels within each group, will be determined by the Technical Committee.

Funding will be retroactive in cases where the Technical Committee needs to delay decisions on funding due to an uncertainty in funding availability.

### **Additional Criteria for Competitors**

#### **Senior Team members must:**

- Demonstrate regular attendance 3x/week (75% of the time) at club competitive training sessions
- Assist in the teaching in teaching judo classes at the Burnaby Judo Club and coaching of younger team members at tournaments

Juvenile and IJF Junior team members must:

- Demonstrate regular attendance 2x/week (75% of the time) at club competitive training sessions
- Assist in the coaching of younger team members at local tournaments

**Priority of Funding**

Within each group the priority of funded activities will be as follows:

Instructors

- NCCP Courses
- Grading
- Judo and Referee Clinics
- First Aid and Taping Courses

Senior Competitive

- Senior and Junior Nationals
- Designated qualification tournaments for Junior World's (case by case basis)
- Out of Province Developmental Activities (case by case basis)
- Provincial Developmental Activities

Junior

- BC Winter Games
- Provincial Developmental Activities

Recreational

- NCCP Clinics
- Referee Clinics

### **Member Qualification Criteria**

In order for any member to be considered by the Burnaby Judo Club to receive club funding, that individual must:

- Be a member in good standing of Judo BC
- Be a member in good standing of the Burnaby Judo Club
- Have been a member of the club for at least one calendar year
- Play an active role in the club's annual tournament
- Assist at the club on a regular basis
- Attend club training sessions at a minimum of 2x/week

\* Under **special circumstances**, the Technical Committee reserves the right to consider athletes for funding that have failed to meet one or more of the above criteria.
